

Position Title: Equine Veterinary Pathologist

Other specialized medical services at AS-EVMC include internal medicine/ neonatal ICU, theriogenology, and anesthesiology/ pain management. In addition, AS-EVMC consists of a state of the art veterinary diagnostic laboratory, including necropsy services. The center offers excellent research opportunities for clinicians that are interested in developing an independent or collaborative research program. Designated research laboratory space, equipped for cell culture, molecular biology, chemistry and endocrinology supervised by a full-time laboratory researcher will be available to assist and coordinate laboratory research activities.

Qualifications and experience: Minimum requirements include 5 years' work experience in Equine Veterinary Pathology along with a veterinary degree (DVM or equivalent) and board certification or similar proven record of specialization in Veterinary Pathology. A research degree (MS or Ph.D.) is desirable.
