Travel Bursary

As part of our commitment to support education in veterinary pathology, the BSVP is pleased to announce a travel bursary for veterinary pathology trainees who wish to attend the BSVP Ocular Pathology Meeting 2018. The bursary is worth £150. All bursary applicants should submit a 10-minute PowerPoint presentation detailing the presentation, diagnosis and outcome of an ocular pathology case. All bursary applicants should also submit the case details to the online BSVP case discussion forum (<http://www.bsvp.org/>). Candidates should include discussion from the BSVP case submission forum in their presentations. Ocular pathology cases from all species are welcome.

The requirements for the travel bursary are as follows:

1. The candidate should be preparing for a board examination (as signed off by their sponsor)
2. The candidate can be of any nationality and work in any country.
3. The candidate shall not have received a BSVP award in the last 2 years.
4. The successful candidate will be required to join the BSVP (and support BSVP activities).
5. The successful candidate will receive free annual membership.
6. All bursary applicants will submit a 10-minute PowerPoint presentation about an ocular pathology case.
7. All bursary applicants will submit an ocular pathology case to the online BSVP case discussion forum (<http://www.bsvp.org/>).
8. The successful candidate will present their ocular pathology case at the BSVP 2018 Companion Animal Meeting (10-minute presentation).
9. The case presentation must be ethically acceptable.
10. Candidates must register to attend the meeting by Saturday 19th May 2018.
11. The successful candidate (s) must make their own travel and accommodation arrangements, once their place is confirmed.
