Travel Bursary

Dear Colleague

The BSVP is pleased to announce a travel bursary for Veterinary Pathology trainees.

As part of our commitment to support education in veterinary pathology, the BSVP will provide one travel bursary, up to £300, to enable a trainee pathologist to attend the meeting detailed above.

The requirements are as follows:

1. The candidate should be officially preparing for one of the boards (as signed off by their sponsor).
2. The candidate shall not have received a BSVP award in the last two years.
3. The successful candidate will be required to join the BSVP (and support its activities) and will receive at least 12 months **free** membership worth £25.
4. The candidate can be of any nationality and work in any country.
5. The candidate will be required to present a case for the case discussion session at the meeting (10 minute presentation, 5 minutes discussion).
6. A PowerPoint presentation must be submitted with the application.
7. The case presentation must be ethically acceptable (both from a scientific as well as from an animal welfare point of view).
8. Register to attend the full meeting by 1st October 2015.
9. Make their own travel and accommodation arrangements, once their place is confirmed

All applications must be sent by email to the BSVP Secretariat bsvpsecretariat@aol.com by 1st October 2015, remember to include a supporting email/letter from your sponsor as well as your PowerPoint presentation.

If two candidates apply the award may be shared equally. If more than two candidates apply a decision will be made by the BSVP Council on the basis of the quality of the PowerPoint presentation submitted with the successful candidate(s) informed in good time so that they can submit their registration form.
