The main vehicular access to the campus is from Bearsden Road/Switchback Road.

### **Sat Nav: Use postcode G61 1BD**

By road, southbound from the M80, follow the signs for the A82 (Great Western Road) then follow the A739 (Bearsden Road/Switchback Road) and head for The School of Veterinary Medicine

By road, northbound from the M74 or M77, follow the signs for the M80, follow the signs for the A82 (Great Western Road) then follow the A739 (Bearsden Road/Switchback Road) and head for The School of Veterinary Medicine

Parking will be available on campus without a permit.

As you arrive on site you go past a Security Station. If you have not been to the School of Veterinary Medicine before, stop at the Security Station where you will be directed as to where to park

The meeting will be held in the Jarrett Lecture Theatre in the Jarrett building (Building V17 in the southwest corner of the site). Refreshments and lunches will be held in the Henry Wellcome Building (V21, adjacent to the Jarrett building, connected via an interior hallway).
